












FLL Explore 75- 2015 | FLL Challenge 303-2016 | FTC 88- 2018 | FRC - this year!!!



Giving and Revenue



Total Raised - \$706,000 (doubled income of previous fiscal year)



FIN Wins

- Introduced Semi-State events to FLL
- FTC switched to Qualifying Tournaments (offers more high-level event experiences & judging to teams)(ALL FTC events now @ tier1 production level)



 ALL FIN events now follow SOP similar to FRC (selection/planning/execution/volunteers/communication)

Awarded \$160,000 in grants to teams! That represents over 20% of our expenses last year.
